Minutes of the November 14 Meeting

**Minutes:**

The Minutes of the City Council of the City of Du Quoin, County of Perry, held on this 14th day of November in the year 2016, said meeting held in the Council Chambers of the Du Quoin City Hall.

**Invocation:**

City Attorney Aaron Atkins gave the invocation.

**Call to Order:**

Mayor Alongi called the meeting to order at 6 pm with the following individuals present: Commissioners Michael Ward, Dale Spencer, Charles Genesio, and Gerald Whitley. City staff included City Attorney Aaron Atkins, City Treasurer Stephanie Cravens, and City Clerk Andrew Croessman.

**Previous Meeting Minutes:**

The Council reviewed the minutes of the meeting held on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of October. Commissioner Ward moved, Commissioner Genesio seconded a motion to approve the minutes. Motion passed; all ayes.

**Approval of Bills:**

Commissioner Spencer moved, Commissioner Whitley seconded a motion to approve the bill list for November 14, 2016. Motion passed; all ayes.

**Proclamations:**

City Attorney Aaron Atkins read the Proclamation honoring the Lady Indians Cross Country team for placing at State. Mayor Alongi presented the Team with the framed Proclamation and individual street signs.

**Ordinances:**

A. 2016-O10-02: An Ordinance Amending Sections 1-3-1 through 1-3-3 of the Ordinances of the City of Du Quoin (Pertains to Elected and Appointed Officials' Salaries). Commissioner Spencer moved, Commissioner Whitley seconded a motion that 2016-O10-02 be approved. Motion passed; all ayes.

B. 2016-O10-03: An Ordinance Amending the Budget for Fiscal Year 2016. Commissioner Spencer moved, Commissioner Genesio seconded a motion that 2016-O10-03 be approved. Motion passed; all ayes.

C. 2016-O11-01: An Ordinance Authorizing the Entry into an Intergovernmental Agreement between the Cities of Du Quoin and Pinckneyville in relation to the Pinckneyville - Du Quoin Airport. Mayor Alongi said that the Intergovernmental Agreement was not

completed yet and asked the Council to table this Ordinance. Commissioner Genesio moved, Commissioner Ward seconded a motion that 2016-O11-01 be tabled. Motion passed; all ayes.

D. 2016-O11-02: An Ordinance Amending Ordinance 1-2-60 (D) (5) of the Ordinances of the City of Du Quoin (Pertains to Banks or other Institutions where City Treasurer is Required to Deposit Funds). Mayor Alongi said that past City Administrations did not deposit money into the Du Quoin State Bank due to conflict of interest. Therefore, the City's Code did not list the Du Quoin State Bank as a Depository Institution. This Ordinance adds the Du Quoin State Bank to the list. Commissioner Spencer moved, Commissioner Ward seconded a motion that 2016-O11-02 be put on public display. Motion passed; all ayes.

**Resolutions:**

A. 2016-R11-01: A Resolution Adopting the Perry County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan. City EMA Director Doug Clark said that the Perry County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan is required by the Federal Government to be updated every five years. This Resolution subscribes the City to the County wide plan. Commissioner Genesio moved, Commissioner Spencer seconded a motion that 2016-R11-01 be put on public display. Motion passed; all ayes.

**Public Agenda:**

A. Open Sealed Bids for EMA generators. No bids were submitted. No action was taken.

**Commissioners' Comments:**

The Council offered their condolences to the family of Private First Class Tyler Iubelt, who was killed serving in Afghanistan. The Council congratulated the Du Quoin Lady Indians Cross Country team on placing at State and the Indians Football team on their playoff run.
