NEIGHBORHOOD VEHICLE PERMIT AS REFERENCED BY ORDINANCE NO. 2009-005-01 AND AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 2012-01-02

A neighborhood vehicle permit authorizes the operation of a neighborhood vehicle, or a utility-terrain vehicle on any street within the boundaries of the City of Du Quoin in accordance with Ordinance 2009-005-01. This excludes US Highway 51 and 152.

The City of Du Quoin is not responsible for any future claims resulting from the operation of a neighborhood or utility-terrain vehicle on the City streets.

It is the responsibility of the vehicle owner to know what roads are designated as permissible for the operation of a neighborhood vehicle.

The owner of the vehicle must provide proof of liability insurance at the time of application.

The vehicle owner must be at least 21 years of age and have a current, valid Illinois driver's license.

The City decal must be displayed on the rear of the vehicle.

All traffic laws must be obeyed, and the vehicle may only be operated between the hours of 4:00 A.M. and 10:00 P.M.

Each neighborhood/utility vehicle must be equipped with brakes, tires, headlamps, front and rear turn signal lamps, tail lamps, stop lamps, reflex reflectors, exterior mirror(s), windshield, seat belts at each seated position, and a parking brake.

The cost of the permit is \$35, and must be renewed annually.
