Minutes of the December 11, 2017 Meeting

Minutes:

The Minutes of the City Council of the City of Du Quoin, County of Perry, held on this 11th day of December in the year 2017, said meeting held in the Council Chambers of the Du Quoin City Hall.

Invocation:

City Attorney Aaron Atkins gave the invocation.

Call to Order:

Mayor Alongi called the meeting to order at 6 p.m. with the following individuals present: Commissioners Michael Ward, Dale Spencer, Charles Genesisio, and Gerald Whitley. City staff included City Attorney Aaron Atkins and City Clerk Andrew Croessman.

Previous Meeting Minutes:

The Council reviewed the minutes of the regular meeting held on the 27th day of November. Commissioner Ward moved, Commissioner Spencer seconded a motion to approve the minutes. Motion passed; all ayes.

Approval of Bills:

Commissioner Spencer moved, Commissioner Whitley seconded a motion to approve the bill list for December 11, 2017. Motion passed; all ayes.

Ordinances:

A. 2017-O11-01: An Ordinance Levying Taxes for Corporate Expenditures for Fiscal Year 2018. Commissioner Spencer moved, Commissioner Ward seconded a motion that 2017-O11-01 be approved. Motion passed; all ayes.

B. 2017-O11-02: An Ordinance Levying Taxes for Library Expenditures for Fiscal Year 2018. Commissioner Whitley moved, Commissioner Spencer seconded a motion that 2017-O11-02 be approved. Motion passed; all ayes.

C. 2017-O12-01: An Ordinance Enacting the Budget for Fiscal Year 2018. Commissioner Spencer and City Clerk Croessman introduced the 2018 Budget. The Budget overview is attached hereto and made a part of the minutes. Commissioner Spencer moved, Commissioner Genesisio seconded a motion that 2017-O12-01 be put on public display. Motion passed; all ayes.

Resolutions:

A. 2017-R11-05: A Resolution Authorizing Appropriation for Maintenance Costs for Streets and Highways for Fiscal Year 2018. Commissioner Genesisio moved, Commissioner Ward seconded a motion that 2017-R11-05 be approved. Motion passed; all ayes.

Commissioners' Comments:

The City Council thanked the Budget and Finance Committee and Mr. Croessman for their efforts in producing a budget.

Mayor Alongi said that the next Council meeting would be on Wednesday, December 27th at 6:00 p.m. due to Christmas. Second, he thanked the Holiday Lights volunteers for their hard work. Lastly, Mayor Alongi said that Jeff Ashauer desired to resign as Zoning Administrator and that he would appoint Doug Bishop for that position at the next meeting.
